Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council concur with the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) action to amend the 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to make the following changes to these Cedar Avenue BRT related projects:

- add local funds for project #190623-25 (roadwork from 164th St. to 181st St. in Lakeville),
- add project #19-623-28 to the TIP in SFY 2011 with local funds used to advance construct a SFY2013 Enhancements funded project (lighting, landscaping and amenities in Lakeville and Apple Valley),
- show new costs for project #19-623-24 (roadwork between CSAH 42 and north of 138th St.),
- reflect a change in scope and revise project costs for project #19-623-23 (roadwork from 147th St., Apple Valley to 181st St., Lakeville).

Background

The Cedar Avenue BRT Transitway is currently included in the 2010-2013 TIP under a number of separate projects. These amendments were requested by Dakota County and are needed to identify several changes to the existing projects including adding additional local funds, changing the a project scope to reflect the updated project termini, revising project costs to reflect the latest cost estimates and including a new Enhancement project being advance constructed with local funds.

Rationale

In order to use Federal Transportation Funds, the project must be accurately and completely reflected in the current TIP. This amendment reflects the most up-to-date funding sources and projects cost estimates for the Cedar Avenue BRT related projects.

Funding

Local funds are being added to the projects. Project #19-623-28 will use local funds to advance construct an Enhancements project awarded in the 2009 Solicitation with federal payback in SFY 2013.

TIP Amendment for Cedar Avenue Transitway Project Changes.

MOTION: The TAB amended the 2010-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add local funds for SP#19-623-25, and Enhancements-funded SP#19-623-28; show new costs for SP#19-623-24 and reflect a change in scope for SP#19-623-23.

BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF ACTION: The scope change for STP funded SP#19-623-23 changes the termini to include the 181st Street Station in Lakeville. SP#19-623-28 is a streetscape project with federal Enhancement funds awarded to it in the most recent solicitation. It is being advance constructed as part of this larger bundle of projects and must be added to the current TIP. SP#19-623-25 is the portion of the project from 164th Street to 181st Street that will be funded using local dollars. SP#19-623-24 is an STP project programmed for 2012 AC payback that must be amended to reflect increased cost from \$10,800,000 to \$13,173,000 from the increase in bituminous cost.


PROJECT BACKGROUND:

1. Briefly describe why amendment is needed (e.g., project in previous STIP but not completed; illustrative project and funds now available; discretionary funds received; inadvertently not included in STIP).

The Cedar Ave. Transitway is currently identified in the 2010-2013 TIP in SFY 2011 and SFY 2012. This amendment is needed to identify several changes to the existing projects: Identify project scope change, add additional project numbers and revise projects costs. The paragraphs below will identify the changes needed:

Project 19-623-23(Sequence #1717) – This project is currently in SFY 2011. The southern project terminus is being changed to include an additional 1.7 miles which changes the original scope of the project. A project scope change request will be introduced at the May 20, 2010 Funding and Programming meeting. The new termini should read: "147th St. Apple Valley to 181st St. in Lakeville". The termini change was made to include the new 181st St. station. Also, the project cost has been revised to reflect the latest cost estimate.

Project 19-623-25(new project number)- This project is being added to identify the portion of 19-623-23 from Upper 164th St. to 181st St. This portion of the project will be funded with local funds. This project number will not show up in the TIP since it is considered associated with project 19-623-23.




Figure 1: Project Area





Figure 2: Project Location Area




