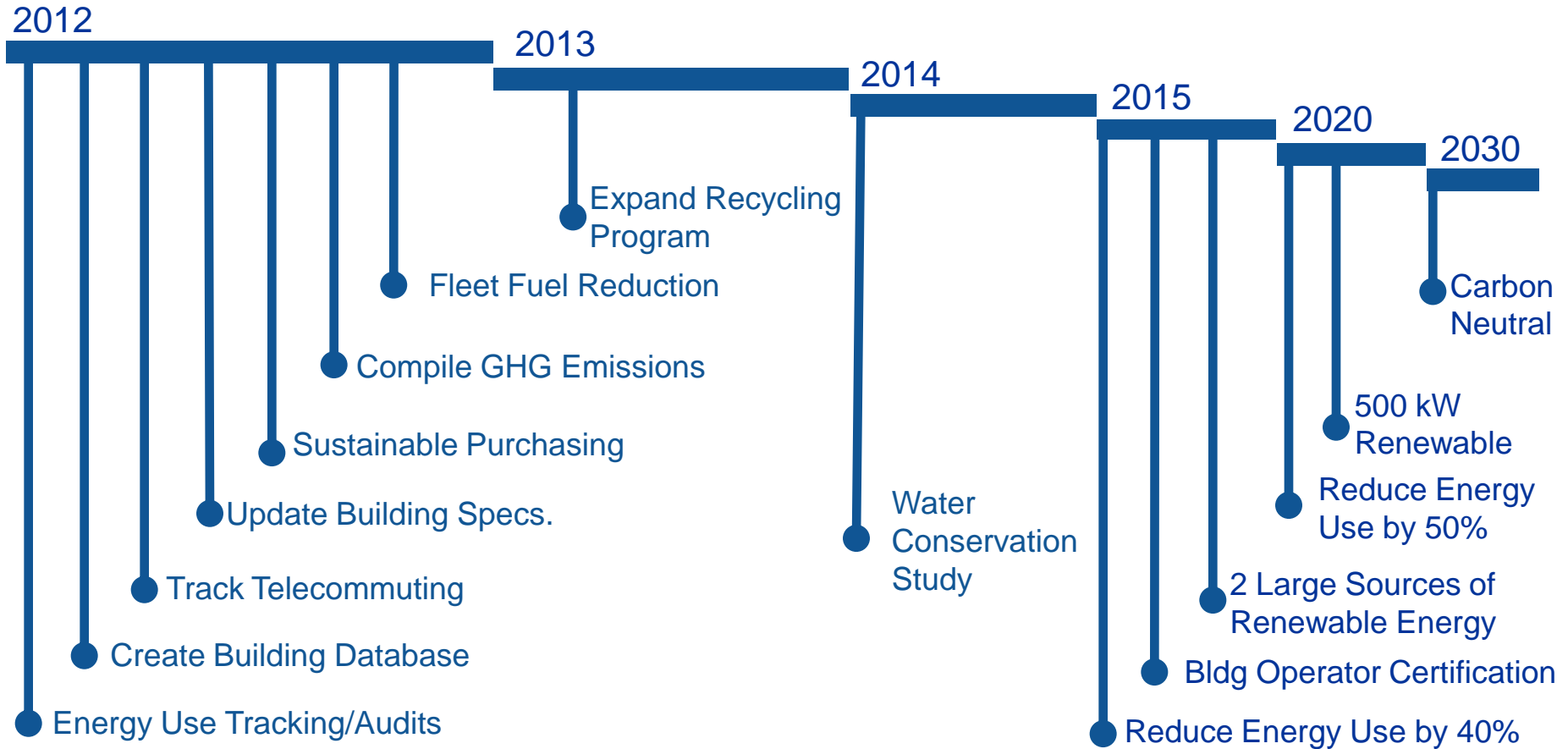

- Designed department wide Employee Sustainable Awareness presentation
- Divided and assigned tasks to specific parties
- Created reference database to store existing support information and current energy and water use data

Executive Order 11-13

Strengthening State Agency Environmental, Energy, and Transportation Sustainability

- April 8, 2011 - Requires state agencies to develop sustainability plan and strongly recommends the Metropolitan Council develop one as well.
- February 22, 2012 – Plan Approved by Board
March 1, 2012 - Plan submitted to MPCA
- August 1, 2012 – Individual Action Plan to be submitted
- August 1, 2013 - Updates to be submitted to the MPCA annually with improvements.
