Proposed Action

Background

The Council has submitted the PHA Plan annually to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) since the year 2000, as required. The Plan includes basic housing agency policies and references to source documents that reflect current operations, programs and services. It is intended to be a convenient source of information for program participants, the U.S. Department HUD and the general public. It provides the Metropolitan Council Housing and Redevelopment Authority (Metro HRA) with an opportunity to articulate its mission for serving the needs of low-income households and the strategies for addressing those needs.

Rationale

Federal regulations for the Section 8 Program require the Council to conduct a public hearing to receive comments on the fiscal year 2011 PHA Plan modifications.
