## **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes the Regional Administrator to reject the bid on Contract No. 11P083 – Control Panel Wiring Harness Fabrication from Corval Constructors in the amount of \$295,214.00.

## **Background**

A formal solicitation was released on June 1, 2011 for the fabrication of analog, digital and power wiring harnesses for installation in the control panels at the Metropolitan Wastewater Treatment Plant (MWWTP). There were five plan holders with only one bid being received on June 22, 2011. The bid received was in the amount of \$295,214.00; the project was estimated at \$141,000.00. Procurement polled the plan holders as to why they declined to bid; various responses were given. Staff will reevaluate the methodology for performing this work and will resolicit if appropriate.

## **Rationale**

The single bid received was much higher than anticipated for this type of work. Other methods of delivering the work are being planned.

## **Funding**

If the bid is not rejected there will be a significant negative financial impact to the installation of the replacement PLC's at the MWWTP.

## **Known Support / Opposition**

MCES management supports this decision as does the Contracts and Procurement Unit.
