### Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to award and execute a construction contract for the Savage Interceptor Improvements – Phase 1, MCES Project 806950, Contract 11P174, to Visu-Sewer, Inc., for their low bid of \$4,658,091.25.

### Background

The project consists of proposed improvements to the existing gravity interceptor system located in the City of Burnsville. Closed circuit television inspection of this interceptor revealed severe corrosion damage and structural deficiencies.

The work includes installation of a temporary conveyance system, installation of cured-in-place-pipe in 12,000 lineal feet of 36-inch gravity sewer pipe, and maintenance structure rehabilitation.

Five construction bids were received on November 2, 2011, ranging from \$4,648,091.25 to \$6,964,151. Visu-Sewer, Inc., submitted the lowest responsive, responsible bid of \$4,648,091.25. The engineer's estimate is \$6,846,300.00.

### Rationale

Construction contracts exceeding \$1,000,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.

### Funding

Funding is provided in the 2011 MCES Capital Program, Project Number 806950.
