Proposed Action/Motion

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to award and execute a contract for construction of the Shakopee Interceptor 70-23 / 69-04 Rehabilitation Project, MCES Project Number 806600 with Insituform Technologies USA, Inc. for their low bid of \$1,149,667.

Issue(s)

- Construction contract awards exceeding \$1,000,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.

Overview and Funding

Video inspection of the Shakopee interceptor (70-23 and a portion of 69-04) indicates heavy hydrogen sulfide damage to the reinforced concrete pipe (RCP). The current project calls for the repair of 7,261 lineal feet of damaged 42” reinforced concrete pipe with cured-in-place-pipe (CIPP). In 2001, upstream from this location, 3000 lineal feet of 36 “ pipe was replaced with plastic pipe due to similar damage.

Upon completion of the rehabilitation, the sewer will be reconveyed to the City of Shakopee.

Five (5) bids, ranging from \$1,149,667 to \$2,026,165, were received and opened on February 28, 2007. The low bid was about 39 percent below the engineer’s estimate of \$1,900,000.

Funding is provided in the 2007 MCES Capital Budget, Project Number 806600.
