Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to award and execute a contract for construction of the East Bethel Water Reclamation Plant and Land Application Basins, Project Number 801622, Contract 11P060, with Rice Lake Construction Group for its low bid of \$13,056,600.00.

Background

The East Bethel Water Reclamation Plant and Land Application Basins will provide metropolitan sewer service to the City of East Bethel. The project consists of a 0.41 million gallon per day tertiary wastewater reclamation plant with biological nutrient removal. The treated effluent will be pumped to two remote land application basins where the effluent will infiltrate into the soil.

Four bids ranging from \$13,056,600 to 14,136,000 were received and opened on December 21, 2011. The engineer's estimate was \$14, 204,500. Rice Lake Construction Group offered the low bid of \$13,056,600. Rice Lake Construction Group successfully fulfilled the bidder's prequalification for the project and has delivered many successful projects to the Council.

Rationale

Contract Award exceeding \$1,000,000 require Council Authorization. There were no goals for minority or women business participation in this contract.
